• 67 of the suspects are black. (79%)

2017 Work and Engagement

- 198,000 people attended community engagement functions with CMPD. These included community forums, Coffee with a Cop gatherings, community corners events, etc.
- 1.3 million calls were handed by 911 center.
- 622,000 interactions between officers and community during their patrols.
- 19,000 arrests made.
- 1800 guns removed from the streets of our community.
- 651 young people joined Diversion Program. 760 referred. 449 of those who entered the program last year completed it.
- Organized the Community Empowerment Initiative, a family-centered, neighborhood-based effort to make it easier for people to access resources that address the individual needs of their families. By working with our non-profit, government and faith-based partners, we are connecting families to organizations that offer after school activities, transportation assistance, job training, healthcare, educational opportunities, etc.
- Began working with community partners in hopes of creating a Family Justice Center in Charlotte. This one-stop shop will bring together resources available for domestic violence victims under one roof to make it both easier and faster for those seeking help.
